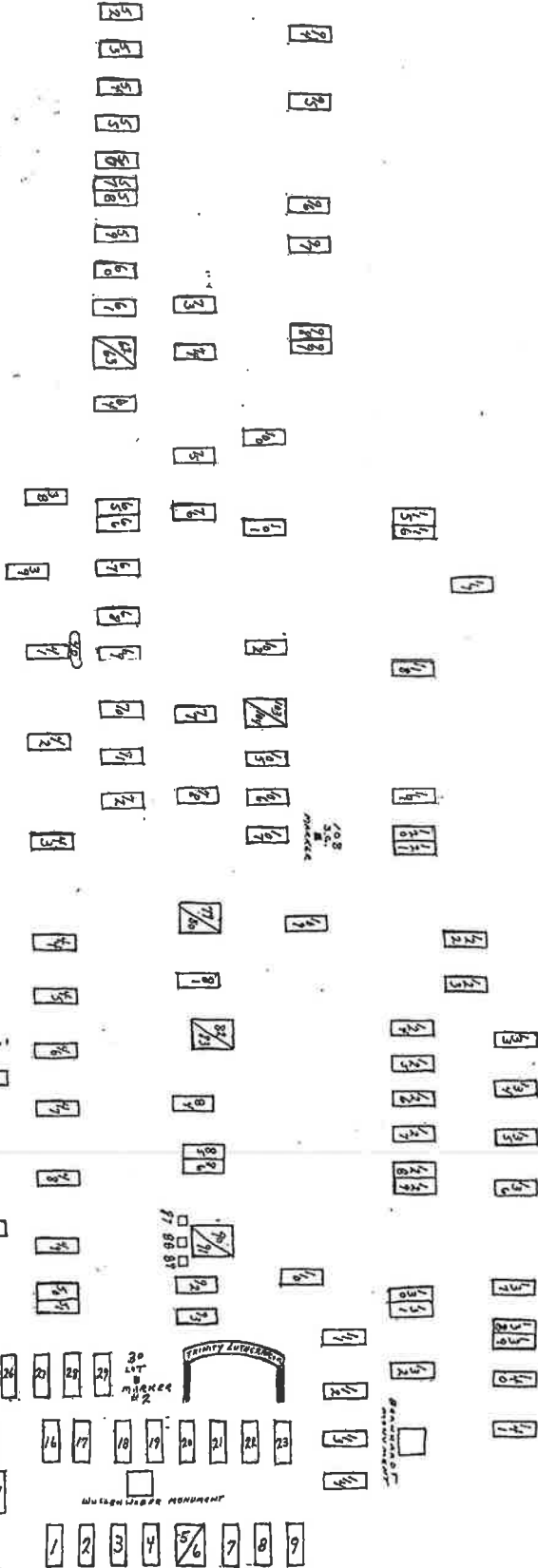

TRINITY EVANGELICAL LUTHERAN CHURCH CEMETERY

COLERAIN TOWNSHIP

The Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church is still an active congregation. On June 4, 1851 a plot of ground for a church was donated by Christian Beerman and his wife, Christina Beerman and recorded at the courthouse for 92 hundredths of an acre. The site of the cemetery and first church building are on the west side of Gaines Road and three tenths of a mile north of Sheed Road. Property was purchased in 1951 on Springdale Road near Gaines Road and in 1953 the congregation approved the construction of a new church at 5921 Springdale Road. The cemetery is seldom used today for burial. There were probably more burials made in the past than gravestone markers that remain today. The gravestone inscriptions were copied by Mr. and Mrs. George Willenbrink (Barbara) in 1987. These records have never been published.

COMPTON FAMILY CEMETERY

COLERAIN TOWNSHIP

Hamilton County courthouse record indicates that this burial site was established for forty-four hundredths of an acre of land. It is located on the east side of Compton Road, east side of Pippin By-Pass and 200 feet south of junction with Kingman Drive in Colerain Township. It is maintained by the Colerain Township Trustees but closed for burials. Evidence indicates that there were more burials than gravestones that remain today. These gravestone inscriptions were recorded by Darryll Hinson in 1982. Records had been previously published in the Historical and Philosophical Society of Ohio Bulletin, Vol. XVI, No. 3, July 1958, pp. 262-263. The numerical listing of names corresponds with plat of gravestone placement.
