The Message: "Coming Home from War"
is based on the Epistle reading: Hebrews 5:1-10

The Old Testament lesson is **Jeremiah 31:31-34**. God reveals to the people that the way things worked before, under the old covenant, would not be the way things worked forever. The Israelites broke the covenant and continue to break it, and so God will make a new one. God will continue to claim His people as His own. They will come to know Him in a new and special way; a knowledge that will come through His forgiveness and grace. The Epistle lesson is **Hebrews 5:1-10**. The high priest always had a special role in the redemptive work of God. However, the high priest was still a sinner and he required a sacrifice for his own sins. Jesus is different. He fills the high priestly role but does not have sins that require payment. As the perfect high priest, He is confirmed as high priest forever. The Gospel lesson is **Mark 10:32-45**. Jesus tells the disciples plainly what will be coming in the near future. After hearing this, James and John determine they deserve places of honor when Jesus receives all that is coming to Him. Jesus uses this opportunity to realign their understanding of what brings glory in the sight of God.
