The Old Testament reading is **Malachi 4:1-6**. Malachi warns of a day of judgment. God will loose His wrath on those who have rejected Him. Despite the anger and destruction of that day, His wrath is reserved only for His enemies. Those who have followed Him will see their salvation and find joy. The return of Elijah will tell everyone when that day is coming. The Epistle reading is **2 Thessalonians 3:6-13**. Paul reminds the church not be gossips and freeloaders. Many others in the world occupy themselves with being a drain on the people around them, taking for themselves and giving nothing back. The church should occupy itself with beneficial work that shows the love of God to our neighbors and cares for them. The Gospel reading is **Luke 21:5-28**. The disciples marvel at the temple and ask Jesus some questions about it. Jesus uses the temple as a lesson to explain what will happen in the as time moves forward. People and countries will suffer many disasters and few things in the world will survive all that time, but these disasters are nothing to be afraid of. Instead, they are a sign that Christ's return is closer than ever before.
